### NARRATIVE

A kind of Paragraph that explains things with examples.

A Kind of Paragraph that creates pictures in words.

A kind of Paragraph that explains a particular topic in a clear and concise manner.

A Paragraph that explains how things work step-by-step.

### CLASSIFICATION

A paragraph that classifies things into Groups and Categories.

A Paragraph that shows Similarities and Differences between things.

### CAUSE & EFFECT

A kind of Paragraph that Explains the Reasons (why) in relation to Results (what) happens.

### PERSUASIVE

A kind of paragraph that is logically influential and Convincing.

## What is a Paragraph?

A paragraph (unit of writing) is a collection of interrelated sentences that discuss a single topic or idea, a concept or theme. The main purpose of a paragraph is to communicate information, provide context, and structure written work. So, it breaks up long sections of text into shorter, more manageable parts.

## Structure of a Paragraph

A complete paragraph has three primary elements:

Topic Sentence

Supporting Details

Conclusion Sentence
